Hannover Industrial Fairs 2009 Concludes Successfully in Mumbai

The four concurrent industrial trade fairs organized by Hannover Milano Fairs India Pvt. Ltd and Deutsche Messe AG Germany concluded here today with a high satisfaction level for most exhibitors.
